Amazing sea life navigates the narrow channels between them including seasonally migrating whale sharks and humpback whales.

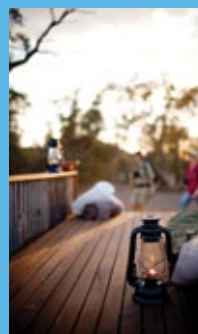

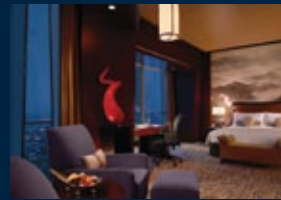
HOW TO SUMMIT, EFFORTLESSLY, IN BEIJING



The well-loved havens that are Shangri-La Hotels and Resorts are flagships of style and design. They are not just the best in lodgings, but an addictive pleasure.

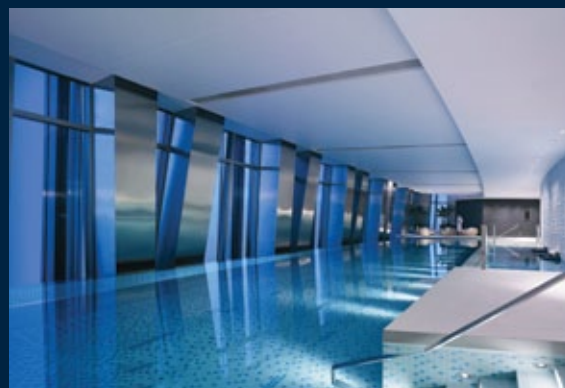

Each floor dazzles with bespoke artworks, fabrics and colour schemes worthy of Emperor Pu Yi or his dowager mother. Opulent and lavish, every truce of the trade has been finessed with impeccable Oriental taste.

Its rooms, restaurants, dining areas and observation deck sit loftily above the city’s streets and Beijing’s highest spa, CHI, sits serenely on the 77th floor. All its therapies are based on Chinese and Asian wellbeing traditions. Moreover, the rituals, philosophies and culture of China pervade every atom of this hotel. The concepts of Yin and Yang, heaven and earth, balance and harmony, are the



complementary dynamics that link the spa with the health club on 78th floor. Ascend in the bubble lift to a gym and a 25-metre infinity pool that seems to float in the heavens.

Floors 80 and 79 are a masterful display of this same beguiling philosophy. The elegant Atmosphere Bar on the 80th floor would not be out of place beneath a real constellation of stars. From the bar guests can descend in a glass lift to the warm and earthy spaces of



79th floor. A wine bar bathed in red hues reminiscent of Chinese lanterns then points the way to Grill 79. This restaurant is in fact two intimate “terraces”, with angled, west-facing windows that allow diners to glimpse Tiananmen Square and the Forbidden City. Similarly, views from west-facing guestrooms, with an average floor space of 65 square metres, extend as far as the rooftops of the Forbidden City.

Astute guests rate this hotel a perfect 10 right down to its earthly core. Breathtaking food, comfort, luxury and service all match the lofty place to which guests are elevated.

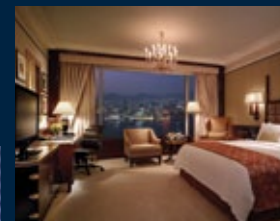


John Chekian believes that *one of the world’s best journeys is the ferry ride across Hong Kong Harbour*. On the frantic harbour shores, right at the doorstep of the posh shopping and entertainment complex of Pacific Place, the Island Shangri-La is an easy walk to a metro station, Victoria Peak Terminal or the famed Star Ferry Terminal. Solicitous service is their mantra. From an arty atrium dominated by a 16-story Chinese mural and from yoga to Yum Cha, this is the pinnacle of hotel perfection on Hong Kong Island.

Those dreamy views are matched at the rooftop bar, Lantern. This poolside bar is open until 1 am so that a perfect evening can be languidly stretched to your liking.

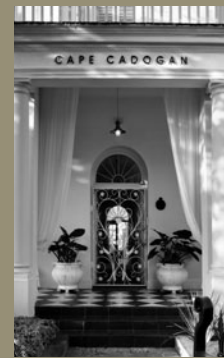
John recommends the signature Red Lantern cocktail, a salute to the area's heritage when red lanterns hung on the pier to welcome immigrants and seafarers.

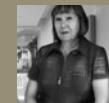
BEAUTY AND THE BEST

What is more than a perfect idea is to arrange a few nights of reckless indulgence or purposeful celebration with family, friends or Sydney visitors. Make the Blu Bar the clubby sanctuary to which you withdraw in the late afternoon for pre-dinner drinks followed by a high Altitude experience. Join your visitors or friends to explore the city outside, or for some individual space you can retreat and enjoy being revitalized in the signature spa, CHI.

WHEN SMALL IS BEST

Adonia is small compared to the vessels of most cruise fleets. Its appeal resides in a sweeping staircase that opens grandly into the lobby, lashings of wood panelling, an elegant library and the space aft of the sun deck where dining venues command sweeping views over the ship's wake. This ship is all 21st century technology wrapped in beautifully crafted detailing.

Adonia is a ship of intimate charm where smart casual is the order of the day, and night dictates a little more formality. There is grand ballroom dancing, afternoon teas and classical recitals – and no kids! Just about everything including the card room has panoramic ocean views and that includes the swish Pacific Ocean Dining Room - the heart of six-course silver-service. Sorrento is an Italian specialty restaurant in the slow food lane and the al fresco Ocean Grill, is popular for not just its cuisine but for excellent wines by the glass.

Eight bars dot the ship but the Crows Nest is the pinnacle for the best daytime views. At night its ambience is perfectly suited for pre or post dinner drinks. The modern gym is a busy hub and thought-provoking lectures generally draw a packed audience. There's a pool, ample space for sunbathing and a pretty spa.

Adonia seems almost perfect: big enough to have plenty of facilities, but small enough to feel like home. Passengers love the camaraderie of like-minded travellers, attentive service and the absence of all things brash. It might sport a trademark yellow funnel but where her sisters might boast of a casino, Adonia is quietly proud of its Anderson's lounge with its clubby leather chairs.

Built to carry just 710 passengers, 75% of Adonia's cabins have a balcony. The importance of this high percentage is anchored in the fact that the Adonia can explore the world's most interesting sea lanes, docking at ports that larger ships are unable to visit.
